<ul> <li>Set a good example to others involved with the club with positive behaviours and actions and help sustain club membership levels</li> <li>Attend and support planned meetings relating to the committee and where you cannot attend, contribute in advance in writing to Chairman and Secretary</li> <li>Dedicate time to undertake committee duties as they relate to your role, being aware of any legal responsibilities you have to the club</li> <li>Deliver on your role, remembering that even as a volunteer, children are counting on you to deliver!</li> <li>Ask for help if you are struggling or stuck with your duties</li> <li>Support and sustain the professional image of the club in the community and with the FA by your actions</li> <li>Look to help and support your fellow committee members wherever possible</li> <li>Support committee decisions and accept collective responsibility for decisions made (even if they were not my preference)</li> <li>Hold VTFC out in a good light in the community and help the committee address any areas of concern discretely, diligently and professionally</li> </ul>	X	Avoid responsibility for your role Bring the club into disrepute by your actions or inactions Fight against, or publicly undermine committee decisions you didn't agree with but were out-voted on Create conflicts of interest between your role here at VTFC and any other matters outside the club that would require you to make decisions against the interest of VTFC. Where that is the case, you must notify the committee in writing (as soon as practicable), and ask another committee member to take such engagements or decisions and abstain from engaging on items that conflict, or consider your own priorities and relinquish your role here at VTFC if the conflict cannot be resolved
