



Parent, carer and spectator code of conduct

At Verwood Town Football Club we want football to be safe and fun for all age groups. The club ethos explains the guiding principles of the club. As parents, carers and spectators we expect you to:

- Remain outside the field of play in the designated spectator area
- Not engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Let coaches to their job and not confuse players by instructing
- Never criticise a player for making a mistake
- Encourage players to respect opposition and officials
- Respect the time that managers and coaches give up to coach their teams
- Report any concerns to the manager, welfare officer or a committee member

By not following the code of conduct then any or all of the following action may be taken:

- Issued with a verbal warning
- Required to meet with the club, league or county welfare officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Undertake an FA education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club to not attend future games
- Suspended or have club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents
